



Grass Caterpillar

What you will need:

1 knee-high stocking
Soil-Grass Seed Mix
3 Pipe cleaners
2 Googly eyes
Glue



Instructions:

1. Take your stocking and fill it with the potting soil mixture that was provided. Make sure to push the soil all the way down into the stocking, packing it tightly. Leave enough room at the end (approx. 4-6") to tie the end with a knot.
2. Tie the open of the stocking with a knot. Trim excess material.
3. Spread a generous amount of glue on to the back of the googly eyes. Place the eyes on the end of the caterpillar that doesn't have the knot.
4. Using the pipe cleaners, create four segments by wrapping the pipe cleaner around each segment, twisting the ends to secure it. The section closest to the head (where you put the eyes), the pipe cleaner can be left longer, instead of twisting it down, leave the ends up to create antennae.
5. Place your caterpillar outside, in your garden or yard.
6. Water generously!
7. Water daily and when the grass grows long enough, be sure send us a picture and give it a funny haircut!

*Be sure to water every day and don't let your seeds dry out.

*You should start to see sprouts in 3-5 days.

* As the grass grows longer, you can give it a haircut!
